

Awning Sash Removal and Sash Replacement

Awning Sash Removal



Step 1

Crank open the awning to expose the split-arm operator hardware.



Step 2

Using a stiff putty knife or a 5-in-1 tool:

- Slide the retaining clips back from the ends of the split arms where they connect to the sash.
- Disconnect the retaining clips from their attachments to the black plastic shoes that slide along the stainless steel track of the sash.



Step 3

Using a stiff putty knife or a 5-in-1 tool:

- Slide the retaining clips back from the ends of the operator arms that connect the sash at either jamb side.
- Pry the arms loose from the pivot pins.

Note: Once both side operator arms are removed from the pivot pins, the sash will come free of the frame, so be careful not to drop the sash once the final disconnection is made.

Awning Sash Replacement



Step 1

Re-connect the side operator arms to the pivot pins and slide the retaining clips back into place.



Step 2

Align the split-arm operator ends with the black plastic shoes that slide into the stainless steel track along the bottom edge of the awning sash.

- Snap the black plastic shoes into place, and slide retaining clips back into position.
- Once all three connection points are established, the window should be operational.
